Leavers' Celebration Assembly

Revision Guides and Textbooks

At the start of the academic year, all pupils were provided with revision guides and textbooks to support them during the lead up to their examinations. Please can pupils ensure they have returned all their books if they have not already done so, by the end of the Leavers' Assembly.

Prom

The Dame Elizabeth Cadbury School Prom 2022 is taking place on Friday 8th July from 7.00pm-11.30pm, at Bromsgrove Hotel & Spa in Bromsgrove. We previously wrote to you informing you of our reduction incentives, these were:

- Attendance of 93% or above by Friday 27th May 2022 = **£2.50 reduction**
- An average effort of "good" or above based on the second data drop at Easter 2022= **£2.50 reduction**
- On track to achieve their target grades at the second data drop at Easter 2022= **£2.50 reduction**
- Support to the wider-school community – for example, Prefect status, Anti-Bullying Ambassador, etc...= **£2.50 reduction**

These reductions are currently being calculated and final balances will be communicated with parents. Outstanding payments must be paid by Wednesday 29th June or their prom place may be cancelled.

GCSE Results Day Thursday 25th August

Pupils are welcome to collect their results from the hall between 9am – 11am on Thursday 25th August.

Any pupil who cannot attend on the day in person will either need to send an email from their school account to hfarrell@decschool.co.uk and the results can be emailed directly to the pupils or they can be collected on behalf of a pupil by a parents but they **must provide a signed note** from the pupil giving them permission to collect.
