This guidance, and Dame Elizabeth Cadbury's attendance policy, reinforces that excellent attendance is central to high levels of academic attainment, as well as preparing pupils for future education and employment.

It is pivotal that parents/carers ensure that their child is in school and on time each day, unless in exceptional circumstances. Attendance is a learned behaviour and if pupils do not attend school regularly then they do not learn the importance of commitment, dependability and good timekeeping.

All pupils must be on school site at 8.35am, so that they are outside their form room at 8.40am. <u>If a pupil</u> arrives after 8.35am then they will receive a late mark and a same day detention

Can I remind parents that full school uniform must be worn that includes a blazer at all times.

Sanctions will be applied to anyone who fails to meet this basic standard.
