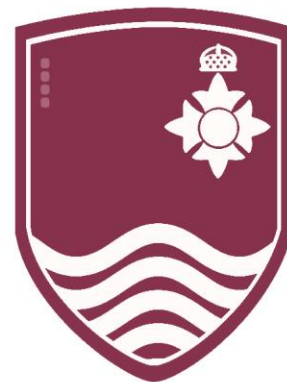

RE: Planned RSE sessions

I am writing to advise you that on Monday 20th March Rebecca Jennings of RAISE (Raising Awareness in Sex Education) will be delivering assembly-style information sessions to pupils in Years 7-11 on Female Genital Mutilation (FGM). Female Genital Mutilation is part of the compulsory Relationships Education, Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) and Health Education in secondary schools as outlined by the Department of Education.

Rebecca has more than 18 years' experience delivering age- and stage-appropriate relationship and sex education and training to primary and secondary schools, colleges, Pupil Referral Units, youth centres and training providers. She delivers workshops to pupils on topics including puberty, sexual health, LGBTQ, female genital mutilation (FGM) and consent.

The sessions will be appropriately adapted for the different year groups and she will cover the following topics:

Awareness of Female Genital Mutilation, the female anatomy, what FGM is (including the physical and emotional damage caused by FGM), the law around FGM, challenging the myths and ideas around FGM and where to find support.
