### **Y13 Results Day Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> August, 8am – 10am**

We hope you and your family are well.

To ensure every pupil feels supported and has access to immediate guidance in the next stage of their education we are inviting you in to collect your results on **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> August, 8am – 10am.**

Please ensure that you bring your subject textbooks, so we can reimburse you for any book deposits made. Please bring your bank account details so a BACS form can be completed for this. Please bring your UCAS Track number with you, so you can log into your UCAS account whilst at school if needed. As a school we are required to inform the government of your intended destination after Sixth Form, this can be higher education, apprenticeships or paid employment. Please bring details of this with you on results day too.

### **UCAS and post-Sixth Form support**

For those of you who have applied to university through UCAS, we highly recommend you log on to your UCAS account and access the Track/Hub area and also check your email address at around 8.15am on results day.

UCAS Track/Hub will update at around 8.15am and you will see if you have been accepted for your firm or insurance choice. If you have not been accepted for either of these then you can then go through the Clearing process if required.

Not being accepted onto your firm or insurance choice does not mean you have achieved “bad grades”. If the universities do not reconsider, you can start the Clearing process by calling other universities that you would like to apply for.

UCAS will not share your exam results with you, you will receive your results from your school. If you are going to use the Clearing process, I recommend starting these phone calls to universities as soon as possible on results day. We are more than happy to help with this process in school.
