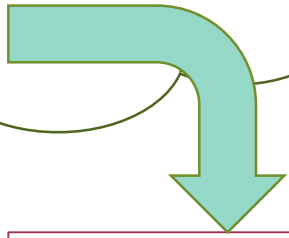

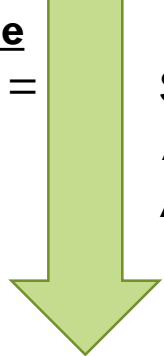
Flag of Israel where Judaism started
