#### Uniform

- There have been no changes to our uniform policy which consists of:
- Black Blazer with school badge (the new badge is now available to purchase if you wish)
- Black Trousers or skirt of a suitable length (not leggings or jeggings)
- · White shirt to be tucked into waistband
- Tie with stripes in House colours
- Smart black shoes

## **Optional School Uniform**

- Black 'V' neck sweater, must be worn with blazer.
- Black, plain headscarves, wraps, bands or hair clips.

Can I please remind parents carers that the black v neck jumper is not allowed to be worn at the expense of a blazer.

Please note that bandanas, false nails and eyelashes are not permitted and pupils will be required to remove these before being able to continue with their school day.







### **Equipment**

As a minimum, pupils should bring the following equipment to school every day:

- Pens (including at least one black and one green pen)
- Pencil, ruler and eraser, in a pencil case
- Glue stick

# **Combined Cadet Force (CCF)**

The CCF is an internal cadet contingent that operates from within the school and is run by school staff. We provide students with opportunities that may not normally be available to them in the outside world.

These activities range from; Camping on the school grounds, Air Rifle Target Shooting in the gym to flying a Tutor T1 Aircraft with a trained pilot. We will provide your child with an RAF Uniform and we also provide your child with the equipment for their training programme so there is no day-to-day cost for attending.

The CCF is also an incredible opportunity for students to develop their own personal attributes such as leadership, communication and organisational skills which will benefit them as they transition to adulthood.
