<u>Can I please remind you that parents/carers will not be allowed to drop off or collect pupils from site for</u> <u>health and safety reasons.</u> Parents and carers must arrange for the safe drop off and collection of their child away from school site. Please consider our neighbours and do not block driveways. **Year 7 will depart school at 2:55pm on Tuesday 2nd September, Wednesday 3rd September and Thursday 4h September**.

Please also be aware that our Open Evening for prospective Year 6 parents/carers will be on Thursday 18th September. The school will close early that day to allow the school to be cleaned and ready for Open Evening. More information will be sent closer to the date.

Medical conditions

If your child has a medical healthcare plan, we will require a signed copy of this to be held in school. Additionally, should your child have a medical condition which requires them to have medication in school, please contact Reception on Monday 1st September to arrange to bring in the medication and to complete the relevant paperwork. Please note that we are unable to administer any medication without written consent from parents/carers.

If your child requires an **Epipen** or **Inhaler**, please ensure they carry this with them at all times. In the case of **Epipens**, we ask that a second, named emergency epipen is also provided to be stored safely in school for use if needed. These should be brought to Reception along with any necessary paperwork.

We do currently hold some emergency Epipen's on site; however, many are close to **expiry**. If this applies to your child, please ensure you provide the school with a new, in-date emergency epipen for storage for the new academic year.

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Equipment

Pupils are responsible for ensuring that they have all essential minimum equipment each day. Please support us by providing a black pen, green pen, pencil, and ruler. Your child will be given a planner on their first day.

Equipment checks will take place regularly throughout the year.

<u>Bikes</u>

If your child travels to school by bike, they should bring a bike lock with them and ensure their bike is locked in our bike store. We also recommend that pupils wear helmets when cycling to and from school.

<u>Attendance</u>

Please be aware that in August 2024 the Department for Education introduced a new national framework for Penalty Notices for school absence. As stated in the new Working together to improve school attendance statutory guidance, *'improving attendance is everyone's business'* and we look forward to continuing to work in partnership with you from September to remove any barriers to your child's attendance.

From September 2025, we will require your child to be collected by a named contact if they are being sent home due to illness or injury during the school day. This is to ensure your child's safety.

<u>Uniform</u>

Year 11 Period 6

To continue to support Year 11 students further, we have created a Period 6 provision for all pupils, which will be invaluable to them over the final year of their GCSE studies. Period 6 will begin on **Monday 8th September 2025**, and Period 6 will run from **3:10pm** until **3:55pm** on **Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays**. Further information will be sent to parents of Year 11 pupils during the first week back in September. There may be further interventions for period 6 placed on Tuesdays and Fridays throughout the academic year, but parents will be notified in advance of these.
