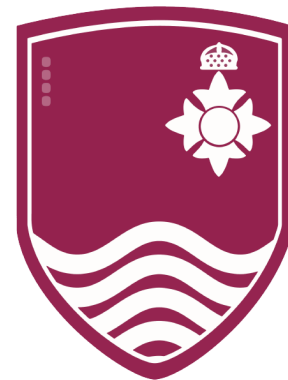

Our personal development curriculum at Dame Elizabeth Cadbury School meets all statutory guidance and prepares pupils for adult life. This includes Relationships, Sex Education and Health Education (RSHE), Citizenship, Careers and PSHE. The statutory guidance has been updated for RSHE for teaching from September 2026. An important part of our curriculum is enhancing our provision with expert external speakers – we will write home to inform you when pupils are receiving assemblies or workshops about sensitive issues. You will also be able to view materials used for the delivery of RSHE from September onwards via our family portal and information regarding this will be sent home at the start of next term.

It is important to us at Dame Elizabeth Cadbury School that we take account of our local and school context and we adapt our curriculum as required to respond to any relevant issues. It is also important that we take account of pupil views and pupil voice is a regular part of the work that we do.
