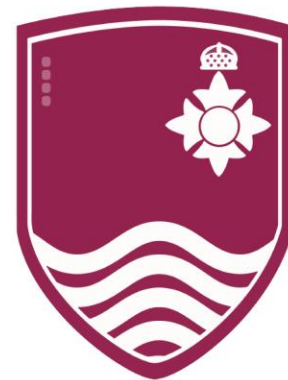

Dear Parent/Carer,

On 14th October 2026, as part of our PSHE programme, we are welcoming Loudmouth Education & Training to Dame Elizabeth Cadbury to perform 'Screen time' for pupils in Years 7 and 8. 'Screen time' teaches pupils about mis and dis information, respect and safety online.

The programme uses well researched drama plus a discussion workshop to help young people identify forms of mis and dis information. The session includes work on respect and how young people can keep themselves safe online.

The statutory Relationships Education, Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) and Health Education guidance in secondary schools from the Department of Education states that pupils should know:

- Relationships, Sexual Health and Health Education (RSHE) should cover the impact of time spent online, the positive aspects of online support and negotiating social media, including online forums and gaming.
- Pupils should know how information and data is generated, collected, shared and used online.
- Pupils should know their rights, responsibilities and opportunities online, including that the same expectations of behaviour apply in all contexts, including online.
- Pupils should know how to identify harmful behaviours online (including bullying, abuse or harassment) and how to report, or find support, if they have been affected by those behaviours.
